

**Bingo receives final development consent for St Marys Recycling Centre; Redevelopment program remains on track**

Bingo Industries Limited (“**Bingo**” ASX:BIN) today announced that it has received the final development consent from the NSW Department of Planning and Environment to expand the processing capacity at the St Marys resource recovery centre (“**RRC**”) in Sydney.

“We’re delighted to secure formal approval for our facility at St Marys, which is just one part of a major redevelopment program Bingo is implementing across NSW and Victoria,” said Bingo Managing Director and CEO, Daniel Tartak.

“Our redevelopment plan remains on track and when completed it will ensure the continued growth of the company,” he said.

The Department granted Bingo the final development consent on 6 November 2018. This development involves the expansion of the existing St Marys Recycling Centre, including construction of a new building to improve the recycling capacity of the facility, and allow for more waste to be recovered through the facility, thereby reducing the waste that goes directly to landfill. It is anticipated the site will be redeveloped and operational in 1H FY20.
