

Workplace Incident at Eastern Creek, Sydney

BINGO confirms that an employee has died and another has been injured as a result of a workplace incident at its Eastern Creek facility at around 1pm today.

The cause of the incident is yet to be determined, and a detailed investigation is currently underway. BINGO continues to co-operate fully with the relevant authorities.

BINGO's priority at this time is the welfare of the deceased man's family, the injured man and his family, and BINGO's employees on the site.

BINGO Managing Director and CEO, Daniel Tartak, said that the incident was a terrible tragedy that has shocked the BINGO family.

"This is a tragic event that has deeply affected our people. We continue to assist the authorities with their investigation, and we are providing all the necessary support to our team on the site.

"The safety of our people and those under our care is extremely important to BINGO. We intend to do whatever is required to understand how this incident has occurred to ensure that it never happens again," he said.

BINGO will provide further detail on the incident at the appropriate time.
